Subject: Frye hearing on DNA in Kings County- Evidence was suppressed.

Today, Kings County Supreme Court Judge Dwyer ruled that two methods of DNA testing developed by the NYC OCME, the Forensic Statistical Tool and Low-copy DNA testing, do not meet the Frye standard and are not generally accepted by the scientific community. All DNA evidence in the case was precluded.
